



## RNS Inner Harbor Feis FAQ's

Q: Is the feis outside?

A: Yes! We will be outside at the Syracuse Inner Harbor. The feis stage will be covered by a tent. There will be areas surrounding the stage where the dancer and guest can set their things, safely distanced from other guests. The guest can watch from that space. We are making arrangements for heaters to be set up, but guests should certainly plan to dress in layers!

Q: What happens if my dancer arrives before their designated check in time?

A: No one will be allowed in before their designated check in time. We can only have 50 people in the dance area at any time, including judges and musicians. If you arrive early, you should wait in your car until your check in time.

Q: Will there be vendors?

A: No- we would love to support our vendor friends, but our venue contract does not allow vendors.

Q: Where/when can my dancer warm up?

A: If you are local, we recommend that you warm up at home, before arriving at the venue. If that is not possible, dancers can warm up in the parking area. We ask that they stay next to their car, distanced from any other dancers. We also ask that the guest remain in the car.

Q: Should my dancer arrive ready to dance?

A: Yes! Please arrive with wig and make up done.

Q: How will I know if the stage is moving ahead or behind schedule?

A: We promise we will not begin competitions early unless all dancers are present and ready to go. We will be posting stage updates on our dedicated social media pages (@2020RNSInnerHarbor on Facebook and Instagram).

Q: My grades dancer is in competitions that are in 2 different check in blocks on the schedule. Can we remain in the dance area while we wait for the 2<sup>nd</sup> block?

A: In general, we are asking people to return to their car if they have an extended wait time between competitions to minimize the number of people in the dance area. If, however, your dancer's competitions are very close together, you do not need to leave the dance area. You do NOT need to be rescreened when you re-enter.

Q: My dancer really wants to cheer her friends on. Can she stay after she receives her awards?

A: No : ( unfortunately in order to meet venue requirements we do have to ask everyone to leave once they have collected their awards

Q: Do I need to collect my marks at the feis?

A: No, they will be emailed to the address used to register within 2 weeks of the feis.

Q: Does my dancer need to be in costume for awards?

A: We ask that all dancers be in costume with their mask on; however, street shoes are fine for awards.

Q: Can we bring camp chairs and coolers?

A: Yes. Please be aware that the park does not allow alcoholic beverages.
